Issues resolved

- Contacts: All contacts linked to a student was incorrectly labelled as Do Not Contact if the first contact linked to the student was set as Do Not Contact

Core Platform

Issues resolved

• Checking whether a date is a school day was not tenanted and may have led to the production of another tenant's result

Academic Reports

Issues resolved

- When both strands and outcomes were set for a subject and a secondary achievement scale was used, the strands displayed an incorrect scale
- Assessment Overview component: When using the target by subject setting, the heading was printing when it was not relevant to the student
- Assessment Overview Component: When this component was not required for some subjects, extra spacing appeared on the printed report
- An issue occurred with the progression point mapping for P or F codes
- An error occurred when importing a reporting period into a different tenant when attitude tags were present.
- An error occurred when attempting to approve student self-assessment comments

Activities

Issues resolved

- Exports: The Medical Information export displayed student medication data on a new screen despite there being sufficient space on the existing screen
- Activity start and end date validation logic was incorrect
- Responses for Permission 'Submitted on' Date and Time were not reflecting accurately
- In certain situations, students were incorrectly assigned to the activity waiting list

 This occurred when a configuration setting to allow a student waiting list was switched off.

Analysis

Issues resolved

- Missing student NAPLAN data was causing a page load error when users attempted to access the Analysis module
- The Attendance charts download was failing due to an error with https server

Improvements

 Stocktake: Enabled the creation of a new cycle when one or more open cycles already exist

Attendance

Improvements

- Added a year filter to the Future Absence Requests screen
- The SCOUT attendance upload will now send Flexible absences for Year 12 after the selected Year 12 last attendance date has passed

Issues resolved

- A student's scheduled activity record was removed when a late entry record for the same day was approved
- Attendance letters containing line breaks were displaying html codes when printed
- An error due to memory size occurred when opening a Future Absences screen containing a large number of requests



 An error occurred when opening the Invalid Data Cleanup screen if no attendance year was available

Attendance PxP

Issues resolved

 When the start time of an incursion matched the start time of the first period and a student was marked absent in PxP, the student was incorrectly marked with a whole day absence in Attendance

Core\Data Sync

Issues resolved

 Roll Classes: For certain schools, the 'No Roll Class' roll class was getting created even though there are no students assigned to the roll class

Curriculum Reference

Improvements

 Victorian Schools: The VCE-VM subjects of Literacy, Numeracy, Personal Development Skills, and Work Related Skills have been added to the VCE Curriculum repository

Enrolments

Improvements

- Removed future students from Inactive Students search within additional modules
 - Wellbeing
 - Student Plans
 - School Attendance

Issues resolved

- The counts between the Students tile, Gender tile and Roll Class statistics were based on different statuses, which caused inaccurate information to display
 - The count on the Students tile has been updated to include 'active', 'active_leaving', 'external', and 'active_pending'.
- Student: The student's enrolment state wasn't displayed correctly for certain students

 Certain students' latest enrolment record wasn't retrieved properly resulting in certain students
 showing an incorrect enrolment state (Alumni, Former Student, Contact, Current Student).
- The count for Students displayed below 'Gender' was only counting students with an Enrolment Status of 'Enrolled - Active', and not Students with a status of 'Enrolled -Leaving'

Fees and Billing

New features

Reports: Fees Collection Report [NSW DoE]

This report is available to NSW DoE schools only.

Each row in the Fees Collection Report displays a summary of all fee items with the same description (e.g. 'Swimming Carnival'), including the number of fees, the total amount of those fees, and the amount and percentage paid.

Health

Issues resolved

 Access: Certain users who selected the Medication widget on the Health home screen were incorrectly directed to Sickbay screen when they had no access



Interviews

Issues resolved

Incorrect time slots were displaying in the printed Interview schedule report

This occurred if unavailability was set in between interview time slots. A warning message has been added to inform users to make sure break times do not partially overlap with one of more interview time slots.

Kiosk

Improvements

 The colour of the messaging text that displays during Kiosk checkout has been changed to improve visibility

Markbook

Issues resolved

- Users with administration access were unable to add comments to calculated columns
- Exporting a markbook was converting grades to numbers when existing cut offs, instead
 of manual cut offs, were used

Messaging

Issues resolved

- Contacts: Searching for contacts via the Address Book resulted in an error if the school had future students belonging to multiple schools
- Contacts: The priority order of certain students' student contacts did not properly sync
 to the data layer if the self-guardianship feature had been enabled in the past

Sentral Setup

New features

 Roll Classes: Added a new roll classes rollover wizard to assist NSW Department of Education schools with rolling over their roll classes to the next year.

The new roll class rollover wizard can be found via Sentral Setup | Administration Data | Roll Classes | 'Roll Over Roll Classes' button.

The wizard is designed to help you with copying over any number of your current year's roll classes for use next year. There are some additional features available such as being able to choose whether the student and/or teacher assignments should be copied as well and the ability to rename the roll class being rolled over.

Student Profiles

Issues resolved

 Reports: The Transition reports never finished generating the reports data, and it remained stuck with the completion status 'Partially completed' and actions listed as 'Generating'

Logic has been added to allow the export to regenerate after an hour has passed since it was last updated.

Reports: The Class List report did not show any details for parents/guardians if there
was only a single parent linked to the student



Timetables

Issues resolved

- Not all duties were displaying on the Duty faculty timetable
 - Duty events will now show in the faculty view even when the assigned teacher is part of a different faculty.
- When a staff member's name contained a diacritic (for example, é), that staff member's timetable was printing with HTML tags displayed
- The NSW DoE SCOUT nightly export was not pushing timetable data to Azure storage for schools on the Enterprise system
- Sentral XLS: The upper limit on classes was causing the import to finish early before fully importing the timetable spreadsheet
- Duplicate rooms were being populated into Timetables when a multi-campus room was used in an Event

Wellbeing

Improvements

 The Date, Period, Student, Year and Creator columns in the Reschedule Detentions table are now sortable

Issues resolved

- Attachments with special characters in the file name were preventing files from opening or downloading
- The merge field for {NawardHistorySubjects} in N-Warning letters did not format correctly when only one subject was in the history

When there is only one subject to print for this merge field, the 'and' before the single subject no longer appears.
