Activities

[fixed] Filtered student selection in Manage Selection

Activities | Manage Selection

You will now only allocate the students selected from the filtered results in Manage Selection. This fix ensures that using 'Select all' after filtering (such as 'Pending Staff Approval') only applies actions to the visible students, helping staff avoid unintentionally processing students outside the filtered group and reducing allocation errors.

Calendars

[fixed] Copying calendars with recurring events

You will now see all events copied correctly when duplicating a calendar that contains recurring events.

Core\Data Sync

[improved] SAIS household address sync (NSW DoE schools only)

You can now sync correspondence and residential addresses from SAIS to the correct address types in Sentral for each household using the importer.

Dashboard

[fixed] Staff data refresh on Birthday widget

You will now see accurate staff birthdays in the Dashboard birthday widget when staff date of birth details are updated or a staff member is marked as deceased.

Enterprise Setup

[fixed] Group removal notification

You will no longer see a success message when a group linked to a tenant has not been removed.

Fees and Billing

[fixed] Warning for departed student in billing runs (Independent and ACTEDU schools only)

Billing | Student Fees Billing

You will no longer see a warning about a missing year level when a departed student with a valid year level is selected for a billing run. You can use the Exclude students with no active enrolment option on the Select Who to Bill page to exclude departed students from a billing run if required.

Flexible Classes

[fixed] Roll display settings now apply to Flexible Classes

School Attendance | Setup | Roll Display

You will now see Profile Flags in Flexible Classes rolls according to the configured Roll Display settings, so staff can view attendance information consistently across all roll types.

Health

[fixed] Scheduled medications on non-school days

You will no longer see students incorrectly marked as present on the Scheduled Medications page for days that are non-school days for them.

Kiosk

[fixed] Attendance kiosk session recovery after weekends

You will no longer experience the attendance kiosk becoming unresponsive when searching for students after a weekend. The kiosk now detects expired sessions and automatically reloads, redirecting users to log in or enter the kiosk PIN again, so attendance processing can continue with minimal disruption.

Markbook

[fixed] Correct alignment and scaling in mark distribution plots

You will now see class names and distribution data displayed correctly in mark distribution plots when more than six classes are included in a Markbook. This ensures class labels remain aligned regardless of the number of classes and chart scaling stays accurate. Showing or hiding classes no longer causes the plot layout to adjust incorrectly.

Portal

[fixed] ACT Digital Account terms and conditions acceptance (ACTEDU only)

New Parent Portal users can now accept ACT Digital Account terms and conditions without issues caused by enrolment matching.

REST API

[fixed] Default consents applied to studentEnrolmentDraft endpoint

You will now see default school consent settings applied when a draft enrolment is created without consent information.

Timetables

[fixed] Duplicate student records in submitted composite rolls

You will no longer see a student appear twice in a previously submitted PxP composite roll after they are moved to another class within the same composite. This prevents duplicate student entries in submitted composite rolls and helps maintain historical roll data when students change classes within the same composite.

[fixed] Email letters when some contacts are missing email addresses

You will now be able to send email letters even when one or more primary contacts for a student do not have an email address, so you can communicate with available recipients without the entire process failing.

- Emails are sent to all contacts with valid email addresses
- Letters are still generated for each contact
- Partial failure messages identify contacts without email addresses
- Supports both 'Create Letter per Student Contact' enabled and disabled scenarios
- Email History correctly displays contact email details for sent communications
