Improvements

 For Victorian Department of Education schools: an update to the 5-point-age related scale has been made

The Victorian Department of Education have recently updated the Reporting Student Achievement and Progress Foundation to 10 policy to incorporate Level D into the 5-point agerelated scale. The 5-point age-related rating now aligns Level D with "below expected level" for Semesters 1 and 2 of Prep and "well below expected level" for Year 1. In doing so, teachers will now be able to accurately report students who are "below expected level" in the early years of primary school.
